ARCHBISHOP WOOD INCLEMENT WEATHER INFORMATION

In the event of inclement weather, please monitor email communication, phone communication and our website to determine opening status. If school is open, students not present will be counted absent and must produce an absence note upon return to school.

• Parents will receive an automated phone call to inform of closure due to weather related issues.

In the event of school closing due to inclement weather: Flexible Instruction Day (FID):

In the event of inclement weather school closing, the FID notification will be communicated promptly via School Messenger phone call to all families and posted on the Archbishop Wood Website (www.archwood.org).

The FID allows students to keep abreast of coursework from home. The FID schedule is as follows:

- Teachers post assignments on Schoology/Power School no later than 10:00 am. Assignments provided should take approximately 30 minutes to complete.
- Teachers are available for "office hours" to respond to student questions via email between the hours of 10:00 am and 1:00 pm.
- Students are required to complete assignments promptly; however, there is a window of 5 school days once school resumes to submit assignments to the teacher.

<u>School Closing With NO FID</u>: In the event of an extreme weather event which results in closure with NO Flexible Instruction Day (FID), official notification that there is no FID will be sent out via School Messenger and a posting on our website.

Two Hour Delayed Opening: Notification of a two hour delay due to inclement weather will be sent via phone (School Messenger) to all families. If Archbishop Wood has a delayed opening but other school districts are busing at the regular time, students may report to school at the regular time. The building will be open and supervised. If the student's home school district reports a two-hour delay and Archbishop Wood is open on time, those students report to school according to that delay. This is not considered lateness to school.

If there is an early dismissal because of inclement weather, School Districts providing transportation for our students will notify Archbishop Wood. Procedures for dismissal will be as follows:

- 1. Dismissal of all students in a given school district as each district notifies us of their decision;
- 2. Dismissal of students by the administration from districts not bused.

3. Parents are strongly urged to encourage their son/daughter to use public school transportation instead of driving to school if the weather is questionable in the morning. The school assumes no responsibility for students who ride home with another student.
